Combating Climate Change: LA's Climate Action Plan

Guest Speaker: Harry Vorhoff will join us to give a presentation the newly-passed Climate Action Plan.

Passed in Feb. 2022, Louisiana's first ever Climate Action Plan contains 28 strategies & 84 specific actions to reduce the GHG emissions across the entire state economy based on "a balanced set of recommendations to limit the severity of climate change, while positioning the state to maintain its economic competitiveness in a low-carbon future."^[1]

Overall, the Climate Action Plan contains recommendations spanning eight sections:

- Clean Energy Transition
- Industrial Decarbonization
- Actively Managed Methane
- Transportation, Development, & the Built Environment
- Natural & Working Lands & Wetlands
- An Inclusive, Low-Carbon Economy
- Collaboration & Partnership to Ensure Successful Implementation
- Accountability & Adaptability to Ensure Lasting Success



Harry Vorhoff is the governor's designee to the Climate Task Force and serves as Deputy Director of the Gov.'s Office of Coastal Affairs. He's also a 2013 graduate from Tulane Law.
