Dear Sirs:

At a regular meeting of our board on March 8, 1949 we passed a resolution requesting a Review Report from the Congressional Committee of Public Works. We are enclosing a certified copy of this resolution.

Under Act 398 of 1946 it is mandatory that the Ponchartrain Levee Board take proper steps for adequate protection from the waters of Lake Ponchartrain in the parishes of Jefferson and St. Charles. We therefore earnestly request that you present this resolution to the proper authorities in Washington with a view of obtaining for the east bank of St. Charles Parish the protection which we so urgently need.

A certified copy of the resolution adopted by the Police Jury of St. Charles Parish has been mailed to Congressman Boggs for submission to the Congressional Committee of Public Works. Your continued interest and assistance will be greatly appreciated.
